



NECMA Update: Indigo & Barnawartha Fire December 2015

THIS UPDATE IS RELATES TO FIRE ACTIVITY IN THE BARNAWARTHA & INDIGO CREEK AREA

North East CMA is aware that this fire event will cause impacts to catchment communities, and has the potential to impact on waterways and river health.

North East CMA has undertaken preliminary desktop mapping and field assessment of immediately impacted priority waterways.

Based on available information, North East CMA has identified fire impacts to the Upper reaches of Black Dog Creek and limited portions of Indigo Creek. North East CMA will continue to monitor impacted waterways over the coming months to assess recovery action as appropriate.

North East CMA has coordinated its response with relevant emergency response agencies and authorities. We will continue to maintain close working collaboration into the recovery phase.
